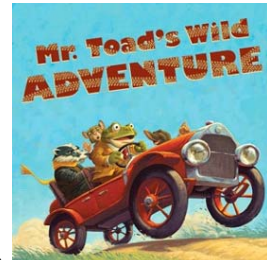

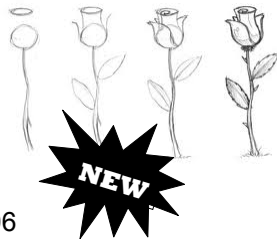

Fee includes six hours of Behind-the-Wheel. Students must be 14-1/2 years of age by the last classroom date of this session. Note: There is an additional permit test fee which is collected by the State of Minnesota at the test center of your choice prior to taking the test. Students cannot take the permit test until they are 15 years of age and have completed the full 30 hours of classroom instruction. Students will schedule behind-the-wheel instruction directly with the driving instructor - the driving instructor will call the student to set up appointments. The permit holder may drive under the supervision of a certified driving instructor, parent or guardian, or licensed driver age 21 or older. The supervisor must occupy the seat beside the permit holder. The permit holder must have the instruction permit for six months with no convictions for moving violations, or alcohol/controlled substance violations prior to taking their Provisional License at the age of 16.
